Understanding Costs

Cost Components

- Base Rate: Guard wages, insurance, training, supervision
- Equipment: Uniforms, communication devices, patrol systems
- Vehicle Costs: Patrol vehicles, fuel, maintenance (if applicable)
- Technology: Guard tour systems, reporting software, cameras

Understanding Rate Structures

Security service rates are influenced by total billable hours and coverage consistency. Providers can typically offer more competitive rates for higher-volume commitments due to:

- Improved scheduling efficiency
- Reduced administrative overhead
- More effective resource allocation
- Consistent guard assignments

For example, a single guard post requiring 24/7 coverage (168 weekly hours) often qualifies for better rates than the same post staffed for limited hours or occasional coverage. Consider your total service hours when evaluating and comparing security quotes.

Additional Cost Considerations:

- Holiday rates (typically 1.5x standard rate)
- Overtime rates for extended coverage
- Emergency call-out fees
- Specialized equipment needs
- Training for site-specific requirements
